Upon successful completion of this course, students will be eligible to take the North Carolina EMT Basic credentialing examination.

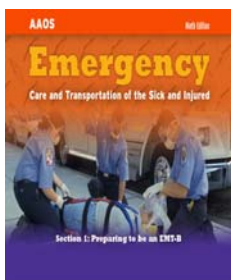
